

5.—WE SUGGEST THAT THE SPINDLE BEARINGS BE CHECKED DAILY FOR THE FIRST WEEK. IF THE BEARINGS ARE TOO HOT TO TOUCH THE REASON IS EITHER INSUFFICIENT LUBRICATION OR DRIVE BELTS ARE TOO TIGHT. TO ADJUST BELTS FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS ON PAGE 6. IT IS IMPORTANT THAT THE TENSION IS JUST ENOUGH TO DRIVE WITHOUT SLIPPING. TOO TIGHT SHORTENS BEARING LIFE TOO LITTLE TENSION SHORTENS BELT LIFE. THE TRANSMISSION BELT IS SELF—ADJUSTING AS LONG AS THE IDLER LINKEAGE IS FREE AND THE SPRING IS TIGHT. THE BELT TENSION SHOULD BE CHECKED DAILY.

CONTROL OPERATING INSTRUCCIONS

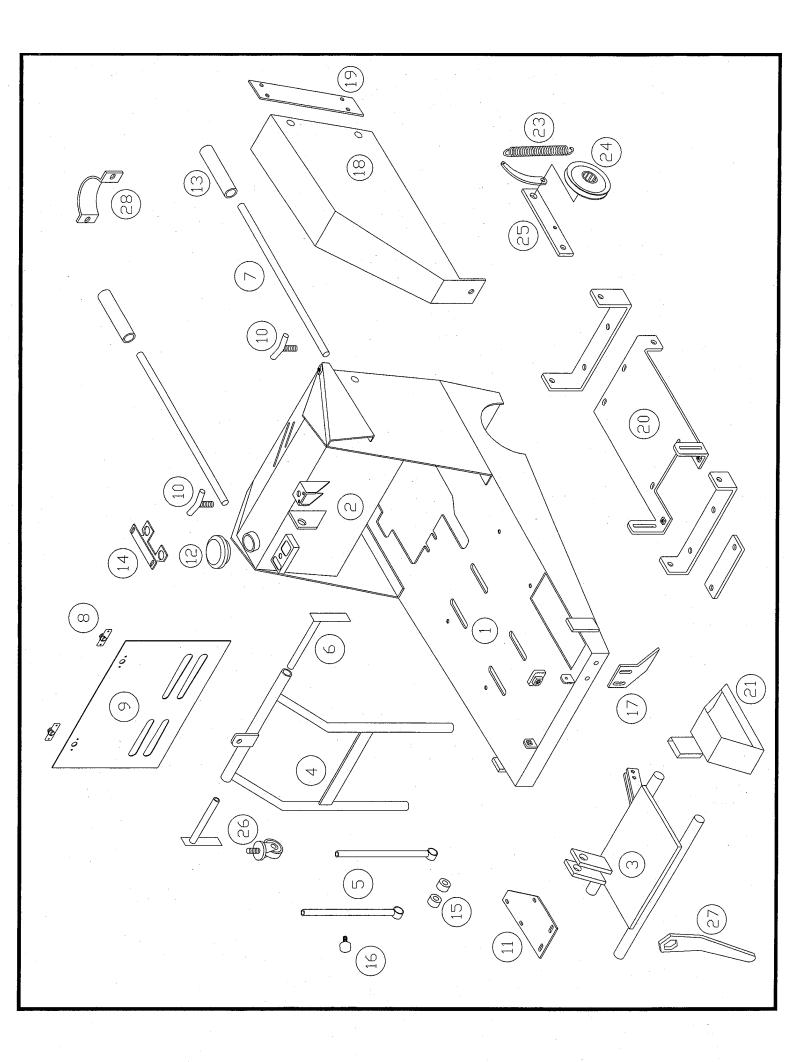
- 1.—WATER SUPPLY: WATER SUPPLY: CONNECT THE WATER SUPPLY TO THE INLET HOSE, OPEN HAND VALVE AND MAKE SURE THAT THE JETS MOUNTED IN THE BLADE COVER ARE FREE OF OBSTRUCTION. THREE TO FIVE GALLONS OF WATER ARE REQUIRED TO COOL THE DIAMOND BLADE ADEQUATELY BLOW OUT WATER LINES IN FREEZING CONDITIONS
- 2.—RAISE& LOWER: BY PUSHING A MOMENTARY SWITCH ACTIVATES AN ELECTRIC OVER HYDRAULIC PUMP TO RAISE THE FRONT OF SAW. TO LOWER SAW, OPEN THE VALVE AND YOU CAN CONTROL LOWERING SPEED BY OPENING THE VALVE GRADUALLY
- 3.—SPEED CONTROL: A SINGLE LEVER DETERMINES FORWARD SPEED AND REVERSE SPEED WITH A NEUTRAL DYNAMIC BRAKE POSITION IN BETWEEN BY PUSHING LEVER FORWARD, THE SAW WILL GO AT VARIOUS SPEEDS. BY PULLING LEVER BACK THE SAW WILL GO BACKWARDS AT VARIOUS SPEEDS.
- 4.— FREEWHEEL: THIS CONTROL IS LOCATED ON TOP OF THE SAW, BY PULLING THE KNOB BY-PASSES FLUID IN HYDROSTATIC TRANSMISSION WHICH ENABLES YOU TO MOVE THE SAW WHEN MOTOR IS NOT RUNNING. (CAUTION: ONLY ACTIVATE FREEWHEEL WHEN ENGINE IS AT IDLE OR OFF) WHEN MOVING THE MACHINE MORE THAN A FEW FEET, START THE ENGINE DRIVE THE UNIT.
- 5.—BLADE FITTING: LIFT OFF THE BLADE, REMOVE THE NUT WITH THE WRENCH PROVIDED RAISE THE SAW ENOUGH TO CLEAR BLADE AND REMOVE THE OUTER HALF OF THE COLLAR INSPECT BOTH SURFACES FOR DIRT OR OTHER IRREGULARITIES AND PLACE THE BLADE ON THE INSIDE COLLAR SO THAT THE HOLE IN THE BLADE SEATS ON THE COLLAR PIN. REPLACE OUTER COLLAR HALF AND NUT USING WRENCH SUPPLIED. TIGTHEN NUT BY STRIKING THE WRENCH HANDLE WITH A HAMMER AND ATTACH BLADEGUARD.
- 6. STARTING THE ENGINE: THIS SHOULD BE DONE AS STATED IN THE ENGINE MANUAL.
- 7.—POSITIONING THE SAW: THE SAW MAY BE MANUVERED IN SEVERAL WAYS. POSITION THE HANDLES
 TO SUIT THE OPERATOR AND CONDITIONS. THE DIFFERENTIAL AXLE ALLOWS THE SAW TO BE
 ROTATED ABOUT THE CENTER OF THE REAR AXLE BY PUSHING THE HANDLES DOWN AND
 LIFTING THE FRONT WHEELS. THE SAW MUST BE MOVED LIKE WHEELBORROW BY LIFTING
 THE REAR WHEELS TO MOVE THE SAW MORE THAN A FEW FEET OR UP AND DOWN RAMPS.
- 8.—CUTTING: LAY OUT AREA TO BE CUT WITH A CHALK LINE OR STRING AND PAINT. LEAD MACHINE INTO CUT WITH POINTER DOWN. WHEN POINTER AND BLADE ARE IN LINE WITH LAYOUT, WITH THE WATER ON, LOWER THE BLADE INTO THE CUT (NOTE) WHEN CUTTING CONCRETE IT IS GENERALY REQUIRED TO MAKE MORE THAN ONE PASS. AFTER SAW THE BLADE REACHES DESIRED DEPTH, MOVE LEVER FORWARD UNTIL SAW REACHES A GOOD CUTTING SPEED. UPON COMPLETION OF CUT RETURN SPEED CONTROL LEVER TO NEUTRAL POSITION. RAISE THE SAW UNTIL BLADE CLEARS PAVING.
- 9. CLEANING: THE ENTIRE SAW SHOULD BE THOROUGHLY CLEANED IMMEDIATELY AFTER EACH USE. A CAR WASH DOES A GOOD JOB. USE CAUTION TO PREVENT WATER FROM ENTRING
- GASOLINE TANK OR ELECTRICAL SWITCHES.

 10.— STORAGE: THE SAW SHOULD BE LUBRICATED AFTER CLEANING.
- 11. CALIBRATION: THE BLADE SPINDLE AND FRONT AND REAR AXLES MUST BE ALIGNED TO MAKE THE SAW CUT IN A STRAIGHT LINE WITH THE BLADE PARALLEL TO THE DIRECTION OF TRAVEL.
- 12 REPLACEMENT PARTS: PARTS MUST BE ORDERED FROM MECO. GIVE THE MODEL AND SERIAL NUMBER OF THE SAW.





Husqvarna will pay return shipping expenses for repaired or approved replacement products.

EQUIPMENT

Equipment manufactured by Husqvarna is warranted to be free from manufacturing defects in normal service for a period of two (2) years from date of purchase by the original consumer purchaser. Component manufacturers offer separate warranty periods. Call Technical Services at 800-288-5040 for complete information.

Our obilgation under this warranty is expressly limited to the replacement or repair at Husqvarna Construction Products North America, Olathe, Kansas 66061, or at a service facility designated by us, of such part or parts as inspection shall disclose to have been defective.

This warranty does not apply to defects caused by damage, unreasonable use, faulty repairs made by others than an approved Husqvarna servicing dealer, or defects cacused by failure to provide reasonable maintenence, while in the possession of the consumer.
